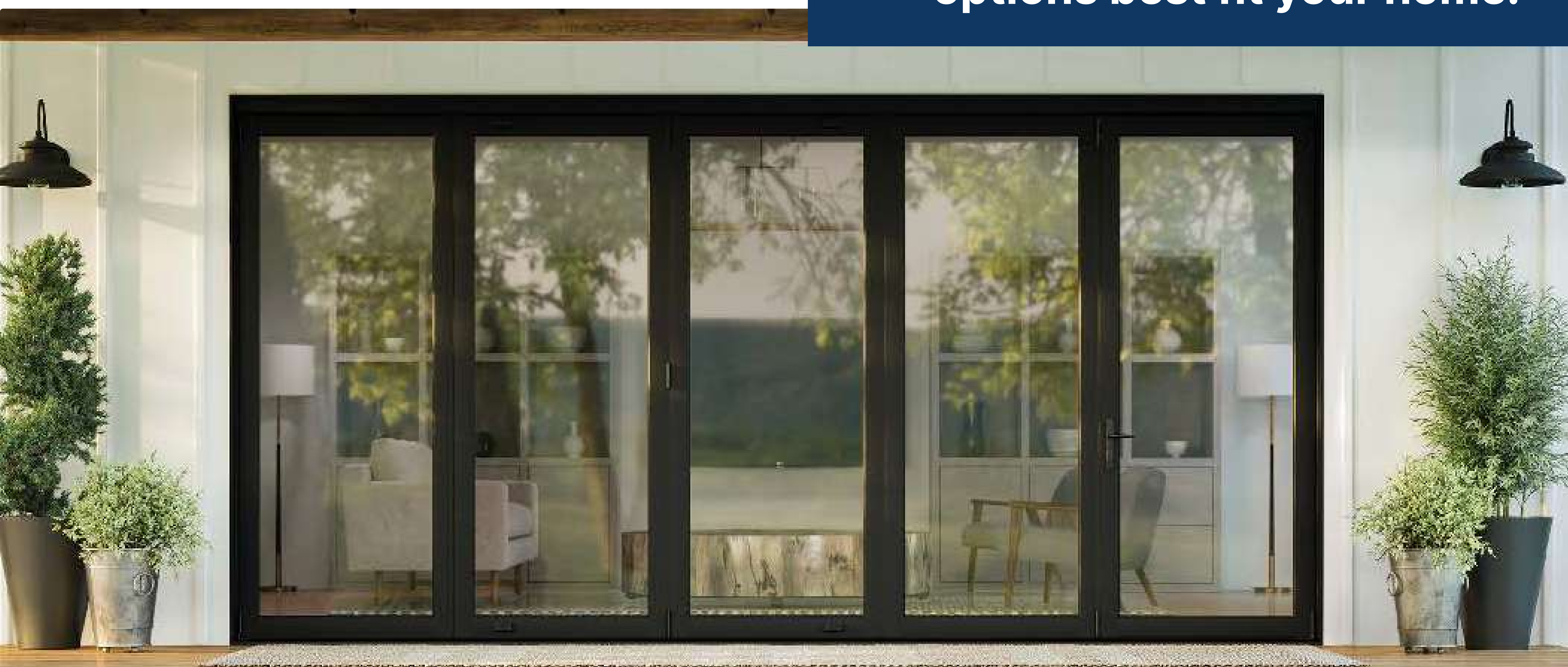

Know the Difference Full-frame vs. Pocket Window Replacement

With full-frame window replacements, the existing window frame and sashes are completely removed down to the framing of the house. A new window is then installed into that opening, typically with new trim added to the exterior and interior. This is a common choice for homeowners who want to maintain the maximum amount of view, want to minimize future maintenance, or want to change the size or shape of their existing window.

Pocket Window Replacement involves removing the existing sashes and jamb liners but keeping the existing window frame in place. Then, a new, fully framed window, is installed into the existing window frame. This can be a good choice if you do not want to disturb the existing trim around the window or are replacing a worn or broken window of the same size as the existing one.
